



Reduce your Global Environmental Impact

Separate #5 PP cartons from your waste

Three Steps for Recycling

- 1) Separate** clean #5 rigid polypropylene cartons from your waste and collapse into compact stack.
- 2) Consolidate** cartons and strap on pallets or in used bins or bags to accumulate a quantity of 200 to 800 pounds each. Use a horizontal baler for large volume consolidation.
- 3) Recycle** consolidated cartons to local recyclers or return to a central distribution center to get maximum recycling value from high volume recyclers.

Maximize the value of Recycling Material

Do not mix with other packaging materials and diligently separate #5 PP from other plastics.

Keep PP material clean and dry.

Bale and accumulate larger quantities. Truckload quantities of up to 20,000 pounds will maximize your economic return from recycling centers

Recycling Centers

Local waste collector

Your current waste collector will typically provide a bulk bin and empty it at no charge and save you the tipping fee for general waste, larger volumes can be arranged for pick up and a refund of 6-12 cents per pound (\$120-\$240 per ton)
